The City of Care

The city that we inhabit today is shaped by our form of production fueled by carbon fossils. In it, in order to exist we need to produce. A fundamental change is needed if we want to overcome the fundamental friction on which we live, to produce we need first to exist. Care, ignored in the economy and 'erased from our cities' tucked into our households, is the labor we rely on to exist, care is today the unpaid labor in which capital is sustained. The current dynamic and the physical realm promotes individuals as actors who must pursue their own labor practices to earn to support themselves, these earnings being fictionally commensurate with their work.
